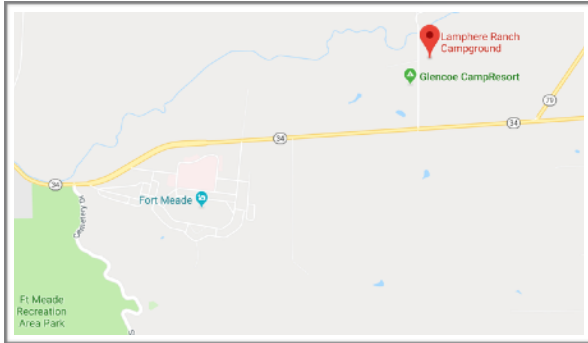


Join us June 4-6, 2019 at the Lamphere Campground, east of Sturgis, SD!!
